

# Maggi Hambling

In 1980 Hambling became the first artist in residence at the National Gallery. She is a painter as well as a sculptor and is well known for her land and seascapes, including a celebrated series of North Sea paintings. She also produces portraits.

Scallop: A Conversation with the Sea is a four metre high steel sculpture which celebrates the composer Benjamin Britten and stands on the beach at Aldeburgh, Suffolk.
